

## **Recognition by US Universities and Colleges**

Please advise your students / families that any time they call or visit a college or university they should ask the name of the person they are speaking with and write it down. This way if there is a case of a staff member not being informed about their universities policies regarding AICE and credit by exam questions, we can deal with it more effectively.

All Florida admissions offices should be familiar with British GCE A Levels or Cambridge AICE. Admissions offices outside of Florida are more familiar with the term 'British GCE A Levels' (which are the exams required to pass at the AS or A level for an AICE Diploma) and you may need to ask to speak to whomever deals with International Student applications.

If you feel your student / family has been given misinformation pertaining to Cambridge A Levels / AICE, the follow up process is as follows:

- 1. Ask them when and with whom they spoke and what they were told.
- 2. Send that information along with the student's name to Sherry at <u>reach.s@cie.org.uk</u>
- 3. Sherry will follow up directly or send it to the appropriate person for follow up
- 4. You will receive correspondence about the action / outcome.
