Earning the AICE International Diploma

- ◆ To earn the AICE Diploma, candidates must take SEVEN courses and pass all seven exams:
 - One exam from Groups 1, 2, and 3
 - AS Global Perspectives
 - ♦ Three additional Cambridge courses from any Group
 - Group 4 credits are NOT required for the AICE Diploma, but may be school prerequisites
- Only two AICE Diploma points may come from Group 4 unless student passes AL Thinking Skills and AL Global Perspectives & Research, then they may use those three
- ♦ All **SEVEN** courses must be completed within **three school years** (a 25 month period)
- Students may apply for their AICE Diploma in 11th or 12th grade, depending on when they start courses or if they need to retake exams they have not passed
- ♦ There are NO MAKE-UP dates for any Cambridge AICE exams
- ♦ WCHS pays for each exam of a class in which students are enrolled and their first attempt at the AICE Diploma
 - ♦ A student who does not pass an exam may pay \$120 for a retake in the **NEXT** testing session
 - ♦ A student who does not fulfil the AICE Diploma requirements in their first attempt may pay for \$135 in the **NEXT** testing session, as long as they sit for an exam that session as well
- Students may choose to take Cambridge courses in addition to the seven required for the AICE Diploma
- Students may opt out of an exam, but by not sitting for the exam their HPA credit will be dropped to Honors for the course and they will be removed from the class at the start of the next semester, if not immediately
- ♦ AICE Diploma candidates who complete the ENTIRE seven course curriculum and sit for all seven exams are exempt from the online course, Fine Arts, and P.E. requirements for graduation.
